Memory Verse: Romans 8:36-37

As you read the passage each day, highlight parts that speak to you. Be ready to discuss why on Sunday. Also be ready to discuss how you were able to make any changes in your actions or attitudes based on what you read.

Monday: 1 Corinthians 15:12-34

What do you think Paul means in verse 31 when he says “I die every day”?

What is Paul’s response in verse 32 to how we can live our lives if the “dead are not raised”? How has this view become popular in our world?

Though reaching out to unbelievers is important (v. 33), how can too close of a friendship with unbelievers affect your faith?

Tuesday: 1 Corinthians 15:35-58

What practical concern was getting in the way of belief in the resurrection of the dead for some of the Corinthians (v. 35)?

What do you believe happens to a person when they die?

What is most comforting when you think about the reality of your own death?

What do you think we’ll look like in heaven? What does the Bible say?
