## Memory Verse: Romans 8:38-39

---

As you read the passage each day, highlight parts that speak to you. Be ready to discuss why on Sunday. Also be ready to discuss how you were able to make any changes in your actions or attitudes based on what you read.

### Monday: 2 Corinthians 1:1-11

How do you respond to intense pressure? Do they deepen your walk with God or drive you away from him?

What's the relationship between God's ability to comfort us and our ability to comfort others (v. 5)?

Who do you know that is under intense pressure? How would Paul have you pray for them?
