Memory Verse: Philippians 4:19

How can a believer be a friend and witness to an unbeliever without becoming “yoked?”

Tuesday: 2 Corinthians 7:2-16

Why does Paul want this church to open up to him (verses 2-4)?

How does Paul’s account of his travels in verses 5-7 illustrate why he began this letter with thanks to God for his comfort (see 1:3-7)?

What was the result of Paul’s previous letter to them (verses 8-13 and 2:3-4)?

What intentions does Paul talk about here?

How is godly sorrow different from worldly sorrow?
