Memory Verse: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

As you read the passage each day, highlight parts that speak to you.
What changes in your actions or attitudes do you need to make based on what you read each day?

Monday: Romans 2:1-16

How do you think God's kindness helps us to become repentant (verse 4)?

What are the consequences of not accepting his kindness?

What does the term "final judgment" mean?

By what standards will God judge us in the final judgment (verses 6-13, 16)?

Tuesday: Romans 2:1-16

The theme of the book of Romans is that we are made right with God through faith, not by good works. How do the standards God will use to judge us in the final judgment match up with the theme of this book?

In God's judgment, what is the reward?

In God's judgment, what is the punishment?

Who is righteous in God's sight?

Thursday: Romans 2:17-29

Friday: Romans 2:17-29

In contrast to physical circumcision, how is "circumcision of the heart" acquired, and what does it mean (verse 29; see Deuteronomy 10:16, 30:6; Jeremiah 4:4, 9:25-26)?

Why is Paul, who was a Jew, so vocal about Gentiles (non-Jews) not having to be circumcised to come into the church?

What custom or ritual do you have that needs to become less of a ritual and more of a matter of the heart?
