Memory Verse: Joshua 24:15

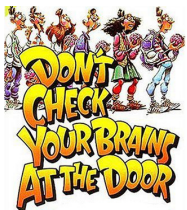
As you read the passage each day, highlight parts that speak to you.

Looking at verses 15-18, on what is God's favor based?

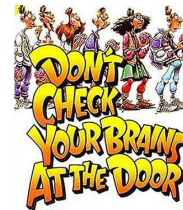


Read the Introduction

Wednesday: Day of Prayer

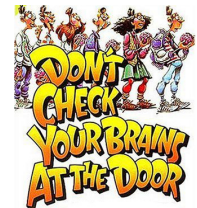

Locate the portion of Jeremiah 1:5 quoted in chapter 1. Circle the personal pronouns in that brief reference.

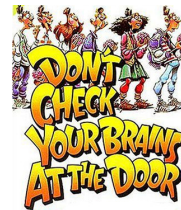
